Under this agreement for 2022 Rainworth State School will receive



\$191,629*

- Maintain 100% above NMS in Reading, Writing and Numeracy for Years 3 and 5
- Maintain the percentage of students in NAPLAN U2B in Reading to 90% (or higher) for Year 3
- Maintain the percentage of students in NAPLAN U2B in Reading to 80% (or higher) for Year 5
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN U2B in Numeracy to 65% (or higher) for Year 3 & Year 5
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN U2B in Writing to 80% (or higher) for Year 3
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN U2B in Writing to 60% (or higher) for Year 5
- For students who may not reach NMS, have an evidence-based plan, developed by the school, in place to address any specific learning difficulties
- Level of Achievement - 80% of students from Prep - Year 6 achieving A's+ B's in English

Our initiatives include

- Establish effective school processes, including Distributive Leadership in order to develop effective efficacy and professional learning teams (PLTs) (Sharratt, L, & Fullan M, 2012 Putting FACES on the Data: What Great Leaders Do!)
- Improve staff capabilities in the use of data analysis to inform teacher practice and student learning. (Hattie, John & Yates, Gregory – Visible Learning and the Science of How We Learn 2014. Archer, Anita & Hughes, Charles – Effective & Efficient Teaching, 2010)
- Conduct Year Level Data Audits with teachers in the analysis and application of learning data to inform learning goals & targets
- Enhance support measures for students. This will include: support from specialised teachers and teacher aides, targeting of resources based on need, tailored programs for individuals or groups and flexible learning spaces
- Engage an Enrichment Support Teacher for Mathematics and Problem Solving
- Provide Professional Development to teachers in Explicit Instruction

Our school will improve student outcomes by

▪ John Fleming Observations: Explicit Instruction and Warm-Up Coaching - 1 visit per Term	\$25 200
▪ Engage DoE Occupational Therapist to assist students with early intervention - 1 day per week	\$25 000
▪ Engage DoE Speech Language Pathologist to assist students with language acquisition - 1 day per fortnight	\$12 500
▪ Provision for year level teams to collaboratively work with HOD-C to support teachers capacity in curriculum planning, instructional design and interrogation of Data: Planning and Data - 1 day per class each term	\$57 029
▪ Engage with "Hear and Say" to assess hearing of students in the Prep Year	\$ 1 550
▪ Engage an Enrichment Support Teacher for Mathematics and Problem Solving – 1 day per fortnight	\$12 350
▪ Engage additional teacher aides to further support literacy and numeracy intervention	\$58 000
